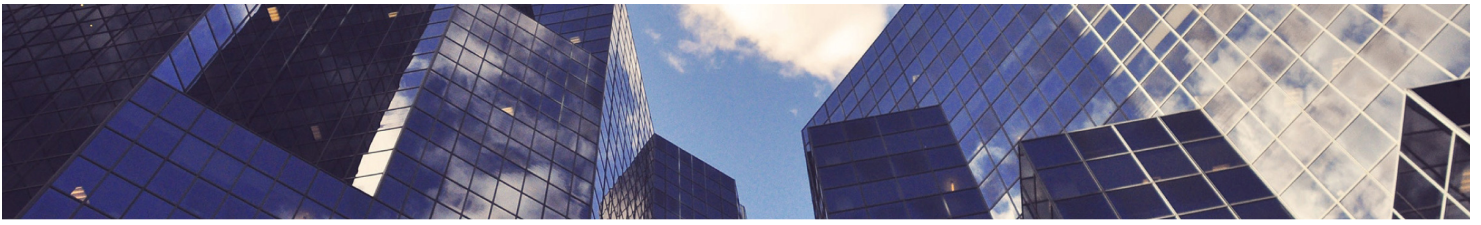

Highlights of his top verdicts include:
